RSO, Choral Arts Society present *Baroque Celebration*

On Saturday, Oct. 23. at 7:30 p.m. the Racine Symphony Orchestra presents, A Baroque Celebration, a collaboration between the RSO and the Choral Arts Society of Southeastern Wisconsin.

Maestro Pasquale Laurino teams up with CAS Conductor James Schatzman to celebrate these two organizations performing together at First Presbyterian Church, at 716 College Ave. The RSO plays Handel's The Arrival of the Queen of Sheba and Overture from Water Music along with Bach's Orchestral Suite No 1. The Choral Arts Society joins the Orchestra in performing Monteverdi's Vespers of 1610. After the concert, the audience may join a reception with both organizations.

The concert is in conjunction with the 9th Annual Daniel Pearl World Music Days. Daniel Pearl, the journalist and musician kidnapped and murdered by terrorists in Pakistan, was a classically-trained violinist, as well as a fiddler and mandolin player who joined musical groups wherever he traveled. World Music Days carries on his mission of connecting diverse people through words and music.

The RSO is also using this concert to give back to the community via the RUSD Instrumental Music Program, by collecting inactive cellphones. RUSD Instrumental music specialist, Eric Weiss uses the phones as a fundraiser for the fifth-grade band programs at Gifford, Johnson, Wadewitz and West Ridge schools. Weiss sells the phones to a refurbishing company, and uses the money for band supplies, music and instruments. Audience members are urged to bring discarded cellphones to the Oct. 23 concert and put them in the green collection container.

Upcoming: Holiday Traditions Pops Concert: The RSO will present its Holiday Pops Concert on Friday, Dec. 3, at Festival Hall. Choirs from Lutheran, Park and Prairie High Schools join the orchestra. The concert begins at 7 p.m.; doors open at 5:30 p.m.
